

## Mini Project Challenge – Terms and Conditions

### General

#### 1. About The Mini Project Challenge

a. DevMads Ltd. is organising an open programmer challenge (“Mini Project Challenge”) – an open programming competition to be held from 24. April 2019 until 31. May 2019. The objective of The Mini Project Challenge is to create a platform for participants to fulfill their potential by showcasing their talent.

b. The 5-Min Video Challenge consists of:

(i) online programming test

The test is prepared with Tetdome online program. The test consist 6 questions and the candidates have 30 minutes to solve it. The best three candidates (the three highest rate of points) will be invited to enter and compete the next round.

(ii) open day at DevMads

Candidates spends 4 hours at DevMads (7626, Pécs, Koller u. 27. 1/3) with the professional staff the 10th May 2019. They can observe how an international startup works. They will be invited to the project-challenge.

(iii) project challenge

The project is a home-work. Each candidates needs to solve the same project until the 24th May 2019.

(iv)award

The best candidates win an Ipad 2018. The award will be given the 31th May bay DevMads Ltd.

2. By registering for and participating in Mini ProjectChallenge, each Participant agrees to these Terms set out herein (as amended from time to time) and all decisions of the Organiser and/or Participating Operator, which shall be final and binding on each Participant.

#### Qualifying Criteria for the Mini Project Challenge

3. The Mini Project Challenge is open to all persons aged above 18 years of age at the time of entry, or those persons below 18 years of age that have the prior written consent of their parent or guardian. Employees and agents of Participating Operators, as well as contractors or subcontractors engaged in connection with the development or operation of the Mini Project Challenge, are not eligible to enter the Mini Project Challenge.

4. Each Participant agrees that in order to participate in the Mini Project Challenge, each Participant must satisfy the following qualifying criteria:

a. successful registration for the Mini Project Challenge Challenge is completed (register for the online programming test); and

b. compliance with these Terms at all times,

5. Each Participant agrees and warrants that all information submitted to the Organiser and/or Participating Operator is true, accurate and complete in every respect (including but not limited to

registration information and information about its Entry). The Organiser and/or Participating Operator reserves the right to verify any and all such information submitted to it.

6. Each Participant agrees and warrants that it has full capacity, authority and legal right to agree to these Terms.

#### The Mini Project Challenge Rules and Judging Criteria

7. The Participant's Entry may not contain, as determined by the Participating Operators in their sole discretion, any content that is sexually explicit or suggestive, unnecessarily violent or derogatory of any ethnic, race, gender, religious, professional, sexual orientation or age group, profane or pornographic material, contains nudity, promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing), promotes any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous, promotes any particular political agenda or message, is obscene or offensive, endorses any form of hate or hate groups or defames, misrepresents or contains disparaging remarks about other people or companies.

8. The Organiser and/or Participating Operator will announce the rules for the Mini Project Challenge and the judging criteria prior to the start of the Mini Project Challenge. The Mini Project Challenge rules and the judging criteria shall be deemed to be incorporated in these Terms and each Participant's continued participation in Mini Project Challenge shall constitute acceptance of these Terms (as amended from time to time).

9. The Organiser will announce the Final Winner and Runner Up at the conclusion of The Mini Project Challenge.

#### Obligations of the Participants

10. Each Participant grants to each of the Participating Operators the right (though it acknowledges and agrees that the Participating Operators shall not be so obliged) to use the Participant's name in connection with the submitted materials and other information as well as in connection with all advertising, marketing and promotional material related thereto. Each Participant agrees that it shall have no recourse against any of the Participating Operators for any alleged or actual infringement or misappropriation of any proprietary right in its communications to the Participating Operators.

11. Each Participant represents and warrants that, at the time of entry, its Entry has not been submitted (in whole or in part) to any other person, and undertakes not to submit its Entry to any competitor of the Participating Operators at any time during the Mini Project Challenge.

12. Each finalist agree to appear at the events.

#### Intellectual Property Rights

13. All intellectual property and proprietary rights in each Participant's Entry shall belong solely to the Participant.

14. Each Participant represents and warrants that they are the sole and exclusive owner of the intellectual property and proprietary rights in such Participant's Entry.

15. All footage in the Participant's Entry must be the Participant's original work

16. It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure that they do not infringe the intellectual property of another person, group or entity.
